

HOW TO ROCK A HEADBAND BRAID

Braids have proven to be all the rage this season— they're kind of a no-brainer hairstyle for any season. This braided headband is perfect for any casual occasion!

BRAID HEADBAND



01.

Create a diagonal part starting from the very top of the head to the temple area. Add a generous mist of Power Spray Fast-Dry Finishing Spray before you begin the braid to tame any flyaways.



02.

Grab a $\frac{1}{4}$ in. thick, 2 in. wide piece of hair & separate it into three sections. Begin by taking the strand in the front to the center, and the center strand to the left—repeat on the right (strand from the right to the center, then center to the right).



03.

As you continue, take a section from the left & pick it up with a bit of the hair from the hairline, then once again cross it over the center. Repeat the same motion with a section from the right.



04.

Alternating the same process (left and right across the center, picking up hair each time), continue braid down towards the ear. Make sure hair remains tight to the head to create a headband effect.



05. Once you run out of hair along the perimeter of your hairline, finish off the section with a regular braid (stop picking up pieces).



06. Complete the braid by tying it with a rubber band, then tuck it under remaining loose hair and secure with bobby pins. Ensure extra tightness by criss-crossing bobby pins to reinforce one another.



FINISHED LOOK
After braid is firmly secured, your headband hairdo is complete!

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
